Charter*

- Recognizing the benefits of maintaining continuity of leadership and quick action in response to rapid development and change, it is recommended that UCIC be led by two co-facilitators.
- Co-facilitators will have joint responsibility (to be worked out between the cofacilitators) for leadership functions of UCIC and for representing its interests and positions to other units of the university.
- 3. Co-facilitators shall implement the actions agreed to by UCIC and report back to UCIC, as to status, within the next two meetings.
- 4. Acknowledging different work cultures and management approaches, one cofacilitator ideally should be a faculty member and the other an administrator or member of the staff at the university.
- 5. Alternating years, each co-facilitator may offer to step aside so as to provide opportunity for others.
- 6. In the event of an emergency, in which one of the co-facilitators must step down, the standing co-facilitator may call out for, or select, a replacement to be approved at the next meeting.
- 7. Elections will be held at a full committee meeting designated in advance (or by email). A simple plurality vote will determine the selection of co-facilitators.
