Foundations/Methods Courses

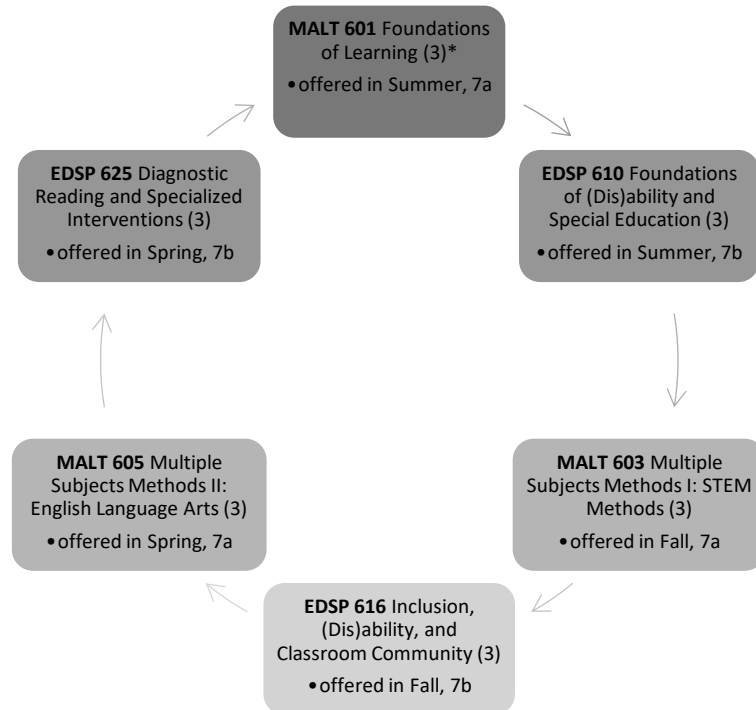
In Term 1, students take the foundations/methods courses offered in semester they begin the program.
