What is the Mentor Program?

The Mentor Program is a seven-month program, from Fall 2020 to Spring 2021, designed to provide students with an invaluable opportunity for personal and professional development through the support of a mentor.

Why participate?

As a Mentee, you will be assigned a mentor who will provide you with additional guidance and support to help you:

- Better define your career goals and options Build your self-confidence
- Enhance your skills and knowledge
- Build your professional network
- Support your overall academic success

How do you become a Mentee?

- You must be a School of Business student entering your final year of the program.
 - Undergraduates must have successfully completed half of the core program with a 2.5 minimum GPA
 - o Graduate students must have successfully completed half of the core program with a 3.0 minimum GPA
- Complete and submit a Mentor Program Student Application, current Resume, a DISC Personality Profile, and a Student Participation Contract.
- Complete and submit a Letter of Interest, describing your mentoring and career goals and why you think you would be a good candidate for the Mentor Program.
- Submit two professional letters of recommendation from two faculty members or a faculty member and work supervisor or colleague.
- Participate in an informational webinar and phone interview.
- Attend the Mentor Orientation & Mixer on October 17, 2020, meet with your assigned mentor once a month at a minimum for a period of seven months, attend mentor networking event(s), and attend the Mentor Program Closing Ceremony on May 8, 2021.
