What is the Mentor Program?

How do you become a Mentor?

- Complete and submit the Mentor Application Form, Letter of Recommendation, a current Resume, Participation Agreement, and a DISC Personality Profile by August 21, 2020.
- Be willing to share your knowledge, experience, and industry expertise with a student.
- Be willing to provide advice and guidance to a student in support of his/her success.
- Attend the Mentor Orientation & Mixer on October 17, 2020, meet with your assigned mentee once a month at a minimum for seven months, participate in monthly virtual mentor team meetings, attend one mentor networking event, and attend the Mentor Closing Ceremony on May 8, 2021.
