Federal financial aid regulations require University of Redlands to issue refunds to the borrowers of Title IV aid within 14 days of a credit occurring on the student's account unless otherwise instructed by the borrower. Due to the nature of the credential program's billing schedule we ask that you consider the options below to simplify your billing experience at the University of Redlands.
